Hours:

MCCA-River Road Fun in the Sun’s hours of operation are 7:15 a.m. until 6:15 pm daily. We are not permitted to take children before 7:15am. River Road will strictly enforced our late fee policy (attached). Late fees are accumulated at a \$1.00 a minute for every minute that you arrive past 6:15pm. If you arrive at or past 6:45 p.m., the fee increases to \$2.00 a minute. We ask that you please follow our sign-in and out procedure each day!

Meals:



We will continue to provide each child with breakfast 8:30am-9:00 am, lunch from Good Food Company at 12:00-12:30pm and an afternoon snack from 3:15pm– 3:45pm. If there is a special dietary need or your child is a vegetarian please fill out the an Emergency Health Plan.



Water Play:

This summer we will be having Water Play on the patio every Tuesday and Friday. All children should bring a swimsuit, towel, swim diapers if needed and water shoes.

(***Please NO CROCS, NO Exceptions***) Please take home any wet clothing items at the end of water play days.

Field Trips:

Field Trips will be held on **Mondays** (except if noted.) More information will be coming soon. Check your child's mailbox daily for more information. Parents will be required to sign the permission slip posted outside their child's classroom door prior to each trip!



Clothing:

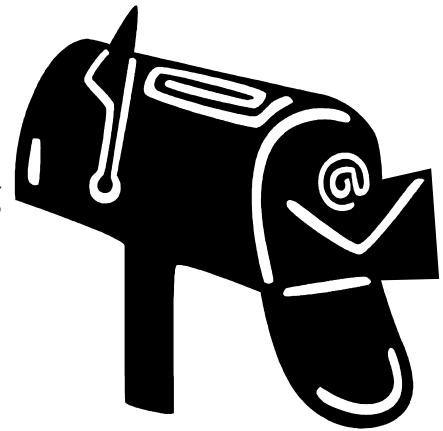
Please send your child in cool comfortable washable clothes and closed toe shoes for play. Remember it's the summer time we will get messy and wet daily. **Please bring in extra clothes.**

Sunscreen and Bug Spray:

This summer each parent will need to sign a form allowing staff to assist with the application of sunscreen and bug spray. River Road will be providing Rocky Mountain SPF 30 sunscreen and OFF Bug Spray that teachers will reapply to the children throughout the day. If you would prefer to use another sunscreen or bug spray please bring it in it's original bottle clearly labeled with your child's first and last name. Please leave the bottle at the center.

**Communication:**

Communication is very important to us. Please be sure to check the white information board daily (located outside the classroom). These boards will give you up-to-date information regarding field trips, important events, and other exciting activities going on. In addition to the boards each child has a mailbox. The mailboxes are used to send home useful information and projects done during the week. Please check daily.



No child will be released to any individual other than a parent or guardian unless the individual is listed on an emergency card or staff receive verbal or written communication.

Toys From Home:

Children may bring toys from home. Please make sure all toys are labeled with your child's name. Please note that our staff will not take responsibility for any toy brought into our program. If a child chooses to bring a toy then it is the responsibility of the child to keep track of it. We reserve the right to restrict toys on certain days or if we feel the toys are inappropriate or are taking away from the summer experience.

**Medication:**

Medication can only be administered to children can only be administered to children with a medical form signed by your child's physician. This includes medications such as ointments, cough drops, children's aspirin , Tylenol, Etc. This is a Maryland state regulation we are required to follow.
